Independent spenders are required to file complete and timely disclosure statements on scheduled dates. *See* Board Rules 14-02, 14-03. A late filing of a disclosure statement is a failure to file if it is not submitted within three days of its due date or by two days before Election Day, whichever is earlier. Independent spenders that report \$5,000 or more in covered expenditures referring to an identifiable candidate are required to report all contributions they receive from organizations beginning January 1 of the year preceding the election, as well as contributions from individuals that aggregate to \$1,000 or more in the 12 months preceding the election. *See* Board Rule 14-02(d). Independent spenders must list donors who have contributed at least \$5,000 during the 12 months preceding the election in a “Paid for by” notice. *See* Board Rules 14-04(a), (b)(i)

On June 21, 2021, the Spender submitted a daily disclosure statement which included five communications, with associated expenditures of \$100,000, distributed on June 16. These communications should have been reported in a June 17 daily disclosure and were reported four days late, constituting a failure to file.



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On April 29, 2022, the Current Authorized Representative reported additional contributions and expenditures not previously disclosed to the Board. One of those transactions should have been reported on June 20, 2021, and the rest should have been reported on June 17, 2021.

The Board assessed total penalties of \$47,500 for these violations.
